Medidata Rave Overview

- Medidata Rave serves as the electronic data capture (EDC) for ALZ-NET.
- Each site staff member that will be entering in participant clinical data **must** have a Medidata Rave account to do so.
 - Your Medidata Rave account will be unique in that the login <u>cannot</u> be used for other applications used for ALZ-NET.

Each user will receive an activation email from <u>Medidata-Notification@mdsol.com</u> after a member of the ALZ-NET Operations Team adds the user to their applicable site.
