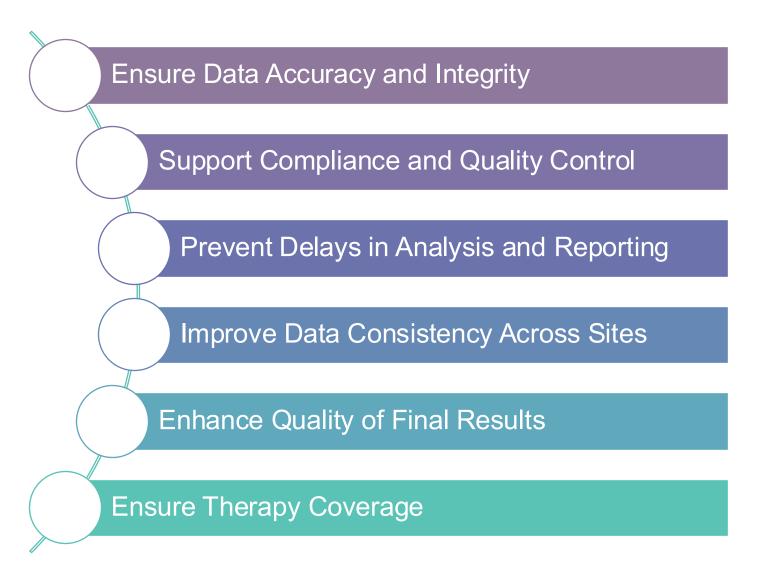

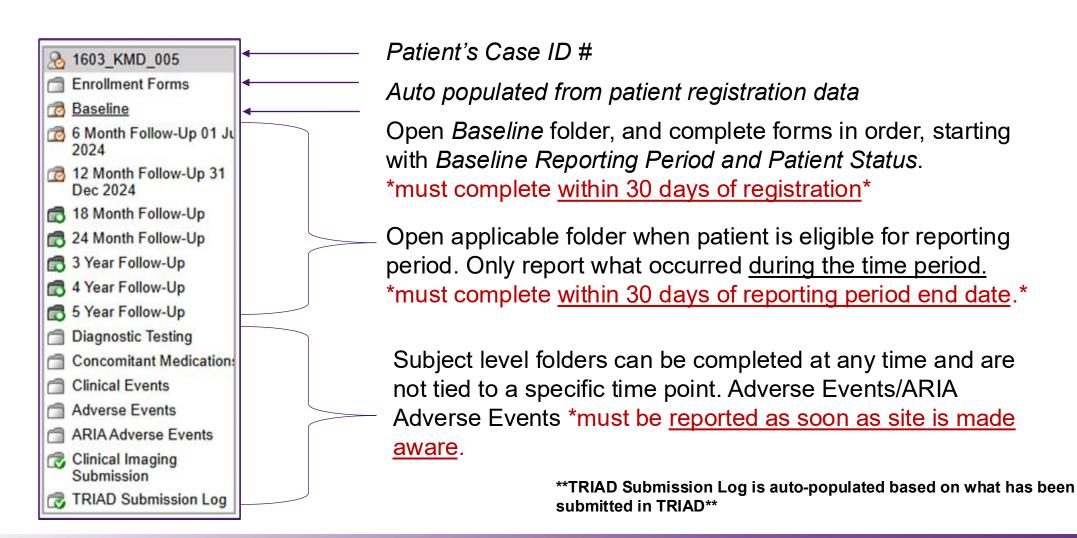

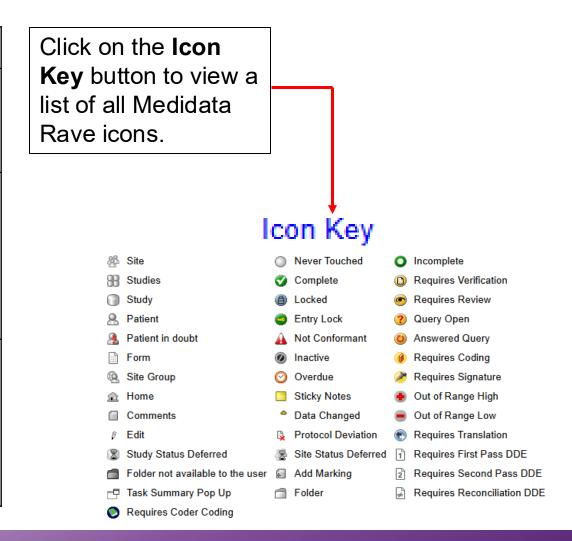
#### **ALZ-NET Folders in Medidata Rave**





## **Understanding Icons in Medidata Rave**

Common Icons	Site Action Required
Complete	All data and queries resolved. No action required.
Query Open	Question about submitted data from ALZ-NET DM Team. Requires site response within 30 days of receipt.
Overdue	Form was not submitted within 30 days. <b>Complete as soon as possible.</b>

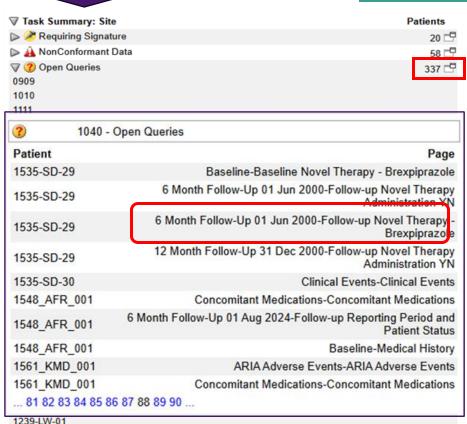




## **Task Summary Tab**



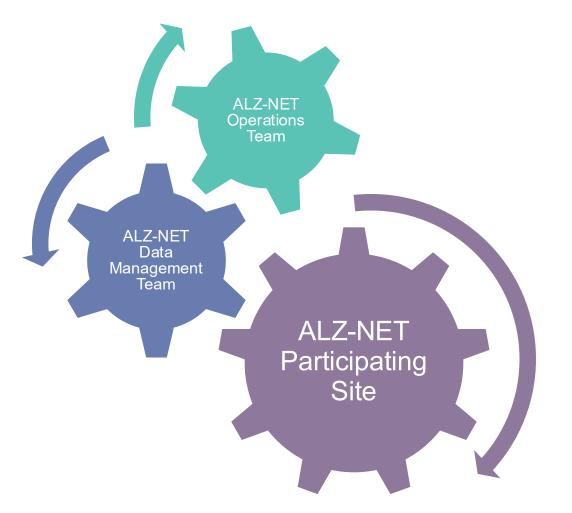
Click the Task Summary arrow to view clickable links to all outstanding queries and overdue forms by patient.



- Task summary located on right-hand side of homepage for each site/patient.
- Click on open queries or non-conformant data numbers to view list of corresponding outstanding data.
- Click on listed forms to be brought directly to them and address the issue.



# **Monthly Data Query Expectations**

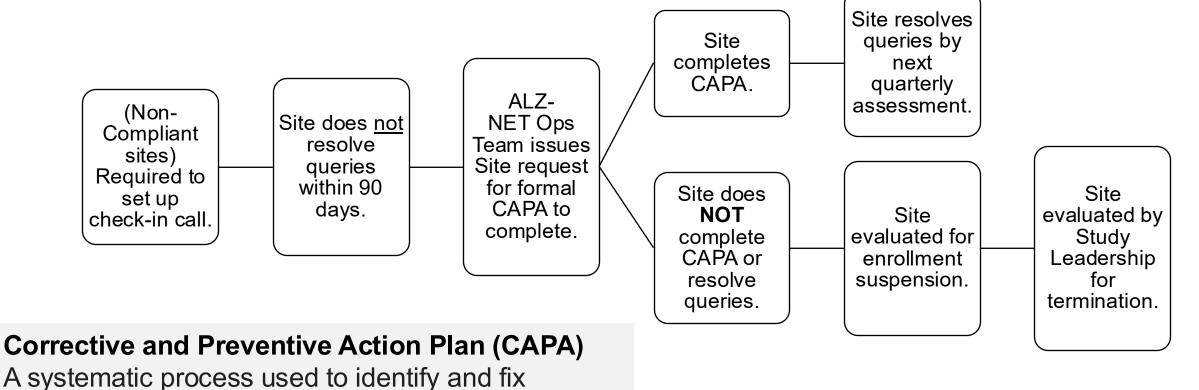


- 1. On the <u>first of every month</u>, the ALZ-NET Data Management (DM) Team sends each site a summary data query report.
- 2. Site assigns designated staff member(s) at site data query review responsibility.
- 3. Site reviews report and addresses all outstanding queries within 30 days of receipt.
- 4. Site contacts DM Team with any questions or concerns at <a href="mailto:alznet-data@acr.org">alznet-data@acr.org</a>.
- 5. Outstanding queries that are not addressed by the next <u>quarterly assessment report</u> may impact a site's overall data compliance score.

# **Tips for Efficient Query Resolution**

Organization & Tracking	Monitor Task Summary Tab in RAVE	Check the Task Summary tab in RAVE daily/weekly for your site to stay on top of outstanding data.
	Use Monthly Query Report to catch any overdue data that may have been missed.	Reports are sent the 1st of each month, and can be used to filter/sort open queries and overdue forms to complete them in RAVE.
	Use Filters to Sort Queries by Priority	In Medidata Rave/Monthly Query Report, sort queries by priority to address the most urgent ones first.
	Use Color-Coding for Status Tracking	Differentiate between pending, in- progress, and resolved queries on your tracking sheet or dashboard for quick visual reference.

	Batch Query Responses Patient-by-Patient	
	Cross-check Data Before Data Entry	
Communication & Collaboration	Hold Weekly Site Check-ins	
	Delegate Tasks Based on Expertise	
	Request Help from the ALZ-NET Data Management Team	



## **Using the Monthly Data Query Report**

On Open Queries tab, FILTER by Subject Name. Review all patient queries in Query Text column.

Use color coding to highlight by type of information (e.g. easy to find, requires physician consult, etc). Search the EMR for all the information you need to answer the queries BEFORE navigating to Rave.

Submit query responses in Rave.

#### Data Timeliness and Form Resolution Priorities

Urgent (Complete Immediately) After selecting patient of interest in Rave, first report if any of these occurred:

- Patient Death
- Withdraw of Consent
- Loss to Follow-up
- Protocol Deviation
- Optional Components Reconsent

- Diagnostic Testing
- Changes to Concomitant Medications
- Adverse/ARIA Events
- Queries related to ARIA events, patient death, adverse events, withdrawn consent.

Complete the following data forms as applicable:

#### **Subject Level**

Can be completed at any time.

#### Baseline/Follow-Up Forms

Complete as forms are opened in RAVE.

#### **All Timepoint Folders**

- Reporting Period and Patient Status
- Additional Measures
- Alzheimer's Disease Diagnosis
- Novel Therapy Administration YN
- Novel Therapy Forms/related queries
- Clinical Imaging

Check for queries routinely:

- Vital Signs
- Novel Therapy
- Lifestyle Data
- Patient Characteristics
- Clinical Features
- Healthcare Utilization/related queries
